EMSA REPORT ON “SEAFARERS’ STATISTICS IN THE EU”

Action required: *Members are invited to note the release of the EMSA report on “Seafarers’ Statistics in the EU”, which is comprehensive source of information on EU seafarers and non-EU seafarers serving on the EU merchant fleet.*

Members are invited to note the release of the EMSA report on “Seafarers’ Statistics in the EU”, which is the authoritative source of information on EU seafarers and non-EU seafarers serving on the EU merchant fleet. It was prepared by EMSA using the data extracted from reports of certificates and endorsements issued by EU Member States, Iceland and Norway, up until 31 December 2018.

The report is attached at the **Annex**.

Members may be aware that amendments to EU Directive 2008/106/EC introduced by EU Directive 2012/35/EU established a mechanism for EMSA to collect information on the certificates and endorsements issued by EU Member States, Iceland and Norway. The original stated objective was for EMSA to collect information for EU Member States and European Commission to use in policy-making.

Although the report describes the 2018 situation, the Secretariat considers it to be the most recent and comprehensive source of this type of information. For example, it may be useful for companies when reviewing their manning strategies and some comparisons could be made with reports from [previous years](#) to identify trends and labour market changes over time. Therefore, Members may wish to circulate the report to their member companies as appropriate.

Some of the highlight figures from the report are as follows:

- **209,192 Masters and officers** held CoCs issued by EU Member States, Norway and Iceland in 2018.
- **106,334 Masters and officers** held original CoCs issued by non-EU countries that were issued with endorsements by EU Member States, Iceland and Norway in 2018.
- Top 5 EU Member States issuing CoCs to Masters and officers were **United Kingdom** (30,716), **Poland** (20,467), **Greece** (20,450), **Norway** (16,366) and **Croatia** (14,291) in 2018.
- Top 5 non-EU countries with the most Masters and officers holding endorsements issued by EU Member States, Iceland and Norway were the **Philippines** (39,145), **Ukraine** (23,449), **Russian Federation** (16,766), **India** (8,594) and **Turkey** (4,997) in 2018.
- Estimated that **2.22%** of Masters and officers holding CoCs issued by EU Member States were female in 2018.

The report also provides demographic information about seafarers, including about their gender and age distribution, by capacity and department.
